

Accomplishments - 2013

Lory State Park: CATS teams helped

prep, cut, stage wood planking for burnt bridges; set wooden piers, assembled and aided in reconstruction of 10 bridges in the park. Systematically, our volunteers worked side-by-side with multiple agencies to build extensive bridge foundations and install bridge protection – rip-rap. Our volunteers aided in rebuilding buck 'n rail fence (burned by the Galena Fire) and later in the year – CATS worked on trail repairs on Shoreline Trail. CATS members installed numerous stone steps, re-aligned trail, installed monowall structures, rip-rap drainages, rolling dips, water bars, and some trail closure.

Reservoir Ridge Natural Area: Cut in 185 ft. of new trail as directed. CATS worked with OMBC on two occasions to install alternative bike routes.

Maxwell Natural Area: Graded trail from Horsetooth (RT 23) at Rotary Parking lot, downhill, and installed a drainage/rolling dip.

Horsetooth Reservoir: Various locations. CATS trail teams worked trail uphill from swim beaching parking, south; installed drainages, rock water bars, and put in good culvert foundation.

Horsetooth Mountain Open Space: Re-aligned Nomad trail. This project involved trail design and full construction accomplished in part by CATS volunteers.

St Vrain State Park: Worked with VOC volunteers in clearing flood damaged areas within park around ponds. Our volunteers assisted in slash pile creation and removal.
